Over the course of the past ten years, leaders in the Archdiocese of Chicago have continually talked about renewal. Some of the renewal is structural -- pertaining to property, personnel, and buildings. However, the renewal is also, as it should be, spiritual.

In many gatherings, discussion turns to corporate sounding terminology such as mission statements and vision statements. During one session, a person offered a very blunt response when asked what a good mission statement would sound like. He said, "To be saints; that's our mission statement."

I wanted to cheer out loud when he said this. Sure, he was being a tad sarcastic, but he was doing so to make a point. Sometimes, amidst all the fancy language, we make things sound more complicated than they need to be.

Leon Bloy expressed it well when he wrote, "The only real sadness, the only real failure, the only great tragedy in life, is not to become a saint."

We keep all this in mind this Sunday as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. The word epiphany basically means "revealing." Pertaining to our faith, it means the manifestation of Christ to the gentiles by the Magi.

A light has shone in the darkness and

this light is the Light of Christ. The good news of salvation now extends beyond the people of Israel to all the world. A life of grace is made possible thanks to the Paschal Mystery of Christ; which is His suffering, death, resurrection and ascension. We can be partakers of divine life, thanks be to Jesus, the Christ; and this means sharing in eternal life.

When we allow ourselves to be guided in this life by the star of Love that transcends this world, it follows that we be saints. We're not talking about becoming an official canonized saint of the Church, but a saint; someone who lives in a state of sanctifying grace. This requires humility (God first), which is the opposite of pride (me first). Humility recognizes our dependence on God and our surrender to God's love and God's law.

Closer to home at Two Holy Martyrs
Parish, the mission is the same: to be
saints. We approach all this not as
some form of personal accomplishment
but as a desire to live a virtuous, holy
life because we love Jesus. Are we still
sinners? You betcha! But keep in mind
the words of St. Josemaria Escriva who
wrote, "A saint is a sinner who keeps
trying."

We must keep trying. The worst thing we could possibly do in life is to give up on God; to give up the faith and backslide into sin, despair, and darkness. We do know this, God never, never, never gives up on us. Do we get discouraged at times? Yes. Do we doubt at times? Yes. Do we slip and sin? Yes. But we should never stop putting one foot in front of the other foot as we make our pilgrim way Home. When we fall, we get back up and ask for God's

forgiveness. If the sin is serious (mortal sin), we should make use of the sacrament of reconciliation. This is a sacrament of healing, and it restores sanctifying grace, which was lost because of serious sin.

If we need a New Year's resolution, allow it to be a renewed commitment to the faith; to Christ. The good Lord always meets us where we are at, but He loves us too much to leave us there. He desires to lead us closer and closer to His Sacred Heart; so much so that we begin to love as He loves. After all, Love is our destiny.

Sanctification (making holy) is the work of the Holy Spirit. Yes, the same Holy Spirit you received the day of your baptism; the same Holy Spirit that strengthened you for mission the day you were confirmed. Call upon the Spirit and make use of the gifts of the Holy Spirit as we recommit ourselves to being intentional disciples of our Lord, Jesus Christ. There are only two directions in life: toward God or away from God. Let's walk together TOWARD GOD!




God's Doorkeeper




