school. Dr. Kathy Berry and I, along with parish leadership, are committed to doing our part to make sure our parish school continues its mission into 2050 and beyond.

Over the next few weeks, we will be introducing the Fr. Norm Trela Tuition Assistance Fund.

As a result of recent inaction by State of Illinois legislators regarding the Tax Credit Scholarship, we need to do something within the walls of the Archdiocese of Chicago and Two Holy Martyrs Parish to help alleviate some of the tuition strain for needy families in our parish school.

Hence, the Fr. Norm Trela Tuition Assistance Fund (TAF). This will be an ongoing fund that can help from year to year. This is more than a one-time deal.

Fr. Norm is a strong advocate for Catholic schools all his life, and this certainly includes his many years of loyal service to St. Laurence High School. He has also been a steady, loving presence for our St. Symphorosa School students and teachers.

As a recent example, last year one of our parishioners presented me with a check for \$4,000. I'm paraphrasing, but she basically said, "My parents made a Catholic school education possible for me. I am grateful, and I want to give back."

Who better to name this Tuition Assistance Fund after than Fr. Norm. Although he is not currently in residence as he rehabilitates from major surgery, his spirit remains in the parish and the school.

Right now, our school tuition for 2024-2025 is roughly \$6,100. We are beginning this academic year with 240 enrolled students. The current number of children receiving aid is just over 80.

Please pray and consider being part of making the Fr. Norm Trela Tuition Assistance Fund a reality. We consider all financial contributions to be an investment in our children and our

reveals a hidden reality. Of course, incense isn't a requirement for God to receive our prayers. Sometimes, people will talk about the "smells and bells" of the liturgy, meaning the immersive aspects of liturgy that allow our full selves to participate in worship and prayer.

The Missal calls for up to five distinct uses for incense in the Mass:

- during the Entrance Procession
- at the beginning of Mass, to incense the cross and the altar
- at the procession before the Gospel and the proclamation of the Gospel itself
- after the gifts have been placed on the altar, to incense the offerings and the altar, as well as the priest and the people
- at the elevation of the host and the chalice after the consecration

To be incensed is to be honored and marked as something or someone who can offer or be offered as sacrificial worship to God. This is why the gifts are incensed before consecration and why both the priest and the people are incensed by the deacon or by another minister. It is a way to recognize the ministerial and baptismal dignity of the Christian faithful. You'll notice that the one incensing bows to the person or object they are incensing.

Incense is also a powerful image at funerals. Near the end of the Mass, the priest reverently incenses the casket or the cremains as a sign of the soul rising to God amidst the prayers of the angels, saints, and all gathered in the church. It also honors the body of the deceased which became the temple of the Holy Spirit at baptism.

There are also three other notable particular uses for incense. The first

is the dedication of a new church or altar. A smoking thurible is placed on the new altar as a symbol of the offerings that will be made there in union with the Son's offering to the Father, and also unites it with the altars of the Old Testament. The second is at the Easter Vigil, when a smoking thurible proceeds the lit Pascal Candle, recalling the pillars of smoke and fire that led the Israelites through the Red Sea and in the desert. The third is during Eucharistic processions and benediction.

Our use of incense is meant to remind us of heaven and the transcendent nature of the Mass. Like the angels, we join in the mystery of worshipping the Lord on his Throne. As St. Paul writes, "Thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads in every place the fragrance that comes from knowing him. For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing" (2 Cor. 2:14-15). Incense is yet another gift we offer God in our praise of him at Mass, one that helps us to engage all of our senses.



You may have noticed that at more solemn liturgies, such as Christmas or Easter, the priest uses incense during Mass. Using a special device called a thurible, perfumed grains and powder are placed on a hot charcoal in order to create a fragrant smoke. The thurible looks like a lidded bowl hanging on a chain. It's also used at funerals and is an option to be used at any Sunday Mass.

Incense and smoking thuribles are a frequent image in scripture. Moses and the priests burn it to venerate the altar and the ark. Psalm 141 says, "Let my prayer be accepted as incense before you, the raising of my hands like an evening oblation." The prophet Isaiah is called in the Temple amidst the holy smoke, which was offered daily. And in John's Revelation, he sees an angel offering incense in praise of God: "I saw the seven angels who stand before God ... and another angel came and stood at the altar with a golden censer; and he was given much incense to mingle with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar before the throne; and the smoke of the incense rose with the prayers of the saints from the hand of the angel before God."

Like many of the sacramentals (holy water, prayer cards, etc.), statues, images, and stained glass, incense is a tangible symbol that more clearly

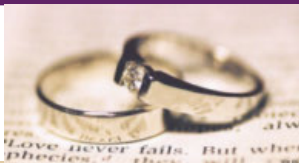

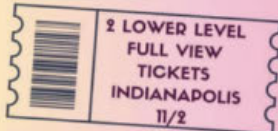
