

Please consider taking time during the season of Lent to read the recently released pastoral letter As for Me and My House, We will Serve the Lord. Printed copies can be found in the church narthex, or you can find a link (pastoral letter 2025) on the main page of our parish website twoholymartyrs.org

This pastoral letter serves as our inspiration and guide during the next five to ten years as we move forward as Two Holy Martyrs Parish. We will continue to honor the past, live in the present, and prepare for the future. The overarching mission continues to be the sanctification of the people and the salvation of souls.

We all play a role in parish life. No one is insignificant. We are the people of God on the southwest side of Chicago. This is our mission territory. We have good news to share, and this good news has nothing to do with balance sheets or budget forecasts. The good news is the Paschal Mystery of Christ; the suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus, the Christ. We are invited to share in this life of grace.

If we collectively and faithfully gaze upon Christ and call upon the Holy Spirit, amazing things happen. The Lord becomes the WHY of everything we do, whether in our personal life

or as a parish. St. Paul wrote "The love of Christ compels us." Compel is a powerful word. We have an obligation to love God and love neighbor.

And please, make the Sunday celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass the center of your week. We gather as a community in person in thanksgiving for what Christ has done for us. What has he done? Eternally conquered sin, evil, and death. He gives his Body on the cross of Calvary and he gives us his Body and Blood in the gift of the Eucharist.

We, in turn, give to the Lord in various ways. In parish life, this is our stewardship; our gifts of time, treasure, and talent. We can each ask, "How can I help our parish?" Away from parish life, we serve the Lord by serving others in need, especially our respective family. John Paul II referred to the family as the domestic church, and parents are the first teachers of the faith. The Church – our parish included – supports families.

Thank you for making Two Holy Martyrs Parish your spiritual home. May we continue to serve God and serve one another in love.

Mission Monday Continues

This Monday evening, we welcome Fr. Dan Korenchan as our speaker for Mission Monday.

We will gather at 7 PM at our St. Rene worship site. Fr. Dan will talk with us about acedia. What is acedia? Today it is more commonly referred to as sloth. It manifests itself as a gloomy combination of weariness, sadness, and purposelessness.

This is a good topic for us during the season of Lent.

Fr. Dan is currently the associate pastor at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in Orland Hills. He was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago in May 2023.

St. Vincent DePaul drop box

As Catholics, we profess that the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son. This has come to be known as the Filioque, which is Latin for "and the Son". It differentiates us from Christians, such as the Orthodox, who profess that the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father through the Son. While this may seem like a trivial aspect of the Creed, it actually tells us a lot about the relationships within the Trinity.

To start, what do we mean here by "procession"? We typically associate the word with orderly movement done for a purpose, like the entrance procession at Mass, a Eucharistic procession at Corpus Christi, or some other type of pilgrimage. In the Trinity, a procession does indicate some source, but not in a causal way. Remember the discussion on the Father begetting the Son – it was not creation, but a divine person as a source sharing and loving another divine person.

In his Last Supper discourse, Jesus speaks these words to his disciples: "The Advocate, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, will bear witness about me" (John 15:26). The word John uses to describe this movement is "to go out as one being sent". It is different from an apostle, prophet, or angel being sent by God, but the divine spirit of life and truth.

Within the Trinity, these processions are how the persons of the Trinity relate to each other as Father, Son, and Spirit, all of the same divine substance but distinct in their persons. These relations are the source of life, as creation isn't itself necessary; there would be an eternal and perfect exchange of love in the Trinity even if man never came into existence.

The Father loves and begets the Son, and the Son receives that love and returns it to the Father as his own gift. In this exchange, the Holy Spirit proceeds from both the Father and the Son as the perfect personal Love, which is mutual self-gift. This exchange is often visualized by a breathing out; it comes from within in an invisible but real way that bears with it something of the person breathing.

The Holy Spirit comes forth from the Father and the Son as love being directed toward another that both unifies and communicates a complete gift of self. It is, however, one shared principle, not two forms of love combining into something new which we call the Spirit. The Spirit is also a person loved equally by two other persons.

So, does it matter if it comes from the Son or through the Son? The concern in the early Church was that neither the Father nor the Son are denigrated as lesser. If the Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son, does that weaken the Father as the unbegotten source of the Trinity? If the Spirit proceeds from the Father through the Son, does that weaken the Son as one who loves and sends the Spirit along with his Father? In reality, both versions are communicating the same idea. Everything the Son has is from the Father.

As St. Ambrose stated, "The Holy Spirit, when he proceeds from the Father and the Son, does not

separate himself from the Father and does not separate himself from the Son." There was never intended to be any division in belief regardless of using "and" or "through". As with many things, politics became involved, and the selection of words became more about what side you belonged on rather than actual belief. However, neither word choice is meant to infer that any of the persons of the Trinity are less than fully divine.

The Filioque was not included in the original text of the Nicene Creed, which stated the Holy Spirit proceeded from the Father (with no mention of the Son). It was added later as a clarification in the continual battle against heresy and the Arianism that would pop up from time to time. It still communicated the truth of the Trinity while not changing the heart of the Trinitarian relations.

I share all this not to get you caught in long-standing theological debates, but to provide the depth of the mystery of the Trinity and the efforts made to help reveal and understand it. Ultimately, we profess a Triune God who willed humanity into existence in a desire to share their own love for each other.

what stage of life you are in.


