Two Holy Martyr Parish

FY 2024 Annual Report - Financial Background Summary

In recognition of the progress that Two Holy Martyrs Parish has made during the past 4 years and to allow the "new" parish the ability to build upon a sound financial foundation... the archdiocese made the decision to forgive the outstanding long-term loans and related interest. This is a summary of the forgiveness:

St. Rene Goupil Total Debt Reduction
St. Symphorosa Total Debt Reduction

The 2024 fiscal year ended on June 30th, 2024. From an operational and financial perspective 2024 proved to be a solid year. Our parish exhibited growth, improved financials, utilization of To Teach Who Christ Is (TTWCI) funding and general campus facility improvements. Accordingly, the church was in the black by approximately \$159,000. This represents a dramatic improvement from 2023. While this improved performance was due to several factors, the dominant area was the generation of new facility leasing income. Aside from this significant upturn other income sources were generally greater than 2023 levels:

Facility Lease Income increased by \$234,079 or 243% Weekly Offertory and Holy Day – Increased by \$9,611 or 1.7% Christmas, Easter and Other Collections Increased by \$3,170 or 2.6% Faith Formation Tuition increased by \$5,384 or 16.9%

Our school also exhibited significant financial improvement for the fiscal year with an increased performance of \$124,357. This improvement resulted in an annual loss of \$159,012. Enrollment continues to increase to 237. In addition, significant outside funding sources generated critical financial assistance for school families who were experiencing financial challenges. A variety of different scholarships, programs and parish aid allowed more students to enter into the school family and remain despite financial hardships. During the mid-point of the year, the Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship program was allowed to sunset by the Illinois legislature. This loss of tuition assistance posed an immediate concern for many of our school families for the upcoming 2024-2025 year. It should be noted that while tuition rates increased modestly, the overall tuition increase did not cover 100% of the added cost of operating the school. Catholic education remains a vital part of our parish and remains instrumental in creating a solid foundation for our adult Catholics of tomorrow.

The 2023 Family Fest could again be categorized as a fundraising success. However, the Fest generated a profit of about \$66,000. This was below our goal and represented continuing downward pressure on Family Fest results. This was driven by increasing vendor costs, increasing security expenses and increased City of Chicago expenses. In addition, planning complexities are increasing, the general liability and risk to the parish are steadily increasing each year, high levels of volunteer commitment are becoming more difficult to obtain and the overall plus and minus assessment for Two Holy Martyrs Parish was becoming less clear and more risky. Accordingly, Fr. Bob and the Parish Council agreed to suspend future Family Fest planning until the overall climate for these types of endeavors improves along with a resurgence in volunteer commitment.

As a result of the Family Fest decision, there will be an immediate need to fill the fundraising revenue gap.. Accordingly, the Grand Raffle was held in the late Spring/early summer. This raffle had record levels of sales and generated a profit of \$30,000. In addition, there will be an increased focus on new fundraising activities throughout the 2025 fiscal year.

During 2024, the parish evaluated several significant projects. As a result, the decision was made to utilize the remaining restricted funds from the To Teach Who Christ Is campaign in an effort to address a couple of needs. These funds totaled \$52,400.81. Accordingly, these funds were completely rolled into the following two parish capital projects utilizing approximately \$70,000:

- St. Rene Church, the Tabernacle area was completely renovated.
- St. Symphorosa Church, the concrete entry stairway was completely replaced along with the concrete landing on the east entrance.

THM parish continues to make a concerted effort to maintain/improve facilities at both campus locations. This tends to be a very challenging goal as we are faced with higher maintenance and utility costs along with a rather tight operating budget. It is important to understand that our two campus locations include a total of 10 insurable structures. These buildings along with their mechanicals are of varying ages and incorporate highly variable states of maintenance and repair. Just as in our homes, we must balance preventative maintenance with upgrades and repairs. These entities require a considerable amount of our financial resources to keep everything operational. Likewise, there will be some significant facility expenditures (ie. Roofs-excludes St. Rene Church) that will be required in the not-too-distant future.

Please feel free to review the following documents which provide various levels of financial detail about our parish. Please note that there will also be more in-depth financial documents available in the back of each church for the next few weeks. As always, feel free to contact the Parish Office with and related questions.

Numerous parish projects and repairs were completed during the 2024 FY.... these include: (see next page)

General Parish Project/Purchases

- The Rectory kitchen was renovated with fresh paint and refinished cabinetry which has brightened up the kitchen for our clergy
- The Rectory hallways were also given a fresh coat of paint to rejuvenate the space occupied by our priests and guests
- Significant improvements were made to the Parish Office These included painting, replacement of old carpeting with tile, redesign of the Parish Office Conference Room, and an overall opening up of the floor plan to improve the staff's ability to assist our parishioners
- The parish purchased additional lawn care equipment to assist in maintaining both campus locations.

St. Rene Goupil Campus

- Repaired a major underground sewer line break on the east side of the St. Rene School Building
- Repaired the commercial refrigerator in Flannery Hall (motor)
- Repaired the circulating pump, fixed coolant leaks and replaced the coolant
- Added/repaired exterior security lighting to the St. Rene campus.

St. Symphorosa Campus

- Managed multiple campus cleanup events with on-site dumpsters discarded broken, old or unwanted parish furniture, office
 items and miscellaneous Items to create a more open and efficient operation at both campus locations
- Due to the extended age of our buildings, pipes, and equipment, additional resources must be utilized. For example, the pipes
 generally need to be professionally rodded a few times during the year. While this is a costly process, it is necessary to keep all
 facilities operational.

St. Symphorosa School

- The Sharp gym received a major upgrade with the addition of two 5 ton air conditioning units that are located in the gym loft
- The Sharp gym had more than 60 panes of glass replaced in the conclusion of a multi-year project to replace and calk the hundreds of gym windows
- The Sharp gym had several new sports equipment closets constructed in previously inefficient areas of clutter
- The school expanded PK to 3 classrooms Accordingly new floor tile was laid in two of these rooms
- Asbestos abatement took place during the summer in one of the PK classrooms to prepare for the new school year
- Classroom 106 was painted and prepped for the new school year
- Additional Security cameras were installed on the campus.

Fundraising Goals/Challenges

An ongoing effort is underway to review and modify all of our THM fundraising endeavors. This is of extreme importance with the uncertainty of a Family Fest return. Accordingly, there is a renewed emphasis in designing new and appealing fundraising endeavors. This effort will be ongoing throughout the current fiscal year. The parish fundraising goal will be approximately \$120,000 per year. This area will build upon the annual Grand Raffle profit of \$30,000, monthly BINGO, and our weekly Split the Pot Raffle.

As new fundraising activities become a reality, there will be a continuing need for more volunteers to step up and assist in some capacity. This will ensure that each fundraiser maximizes it's potential to assist the parish.

Potential Projects for 2025

As we round the bend into 2025, the parish is hopeful that our financial position will allow the parish to embark upon the next phase of the Parking lot projects. Once implemented, these will benefit both of our campus locations and will utilize fundraising dollars, as much as possible.

Good News

Two Holy Martyrs Parish is evolving. All signs are pointing up. Financials are generally improving with the addition of a full year of lease income, and the October Mass attendance numbers are increasing. Continued progress throughout the remainder of the 2025 FY is anticipated.
